

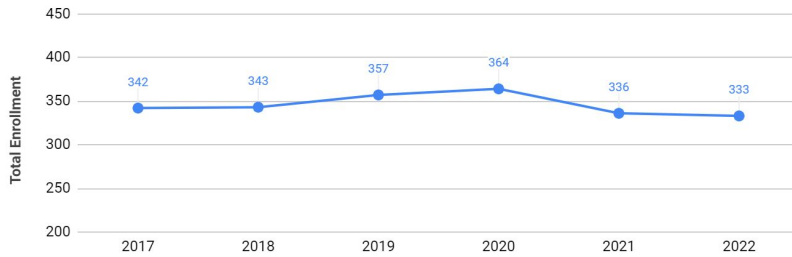

Enrollment trends for Boyd County Schools have stayed fairly consistent over the last 5 years.

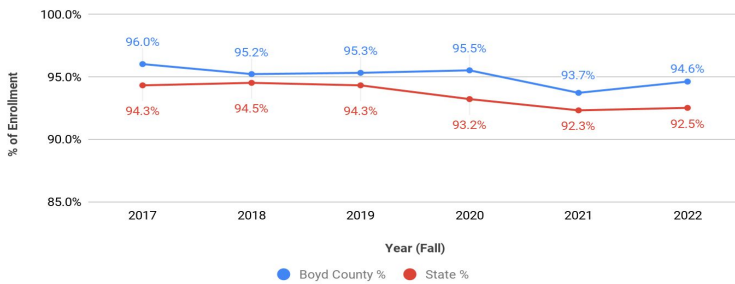
