## BOYD COUNTY SCHOOLS SUMMER FEEDING PROGRAM

Kids still need a healthy diet, even when school is out. Boyd County Schools is considering offering a Summer Feeding Program. Schools participating in the National School Lunch Program are eligible to provide both breakfast and lunch *FREE OF CHARGE* to all children 1-18 years of age. The Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) serves meals with milk, meat, fruits, vegetables and bread. Meals have all the good things that children need to grow up strong and healthy. Feeding dates would begin on June 3<sup>rd</sup> and continue thru July 19<sup>th</sup>.

This program cannot be offered unless there is a majority of community interest.
If you are interested, please respond to the school with the option of your choice by May 8th if possible.
Option 1:Food would be bagged in individual bags, one breakfast per bag and one lunch per bag. Five different lunches and breakfasts would then be packaged for each individual receiving the food. Food would be frozen and could be reheated as desired. Pickup would be available one day per week during a designated time at any of the three schools, Spencer, Lynch and Butte. This is the same as provided to you during Covid. This would only need to be picked up once per week.
Option 2:Food for one day would be cooked, packaged, and made available during the pickup time set. Then, we would also send two days of cold lunches and three breakfasts as mentioned above. Then on day 4 of that week, we would again offer a hot meal for pickup along with one day of frozen lunch and two breakfast meals. This would require a two day per week pickup.
